The newly reformed Mystery Bay Coastcare group had their first working bee on Wednesday 3rd December. This follows two training sessions with Land Services Officer, Peter Gow, on Bushcare skills and action planning. Nine people participated in the planned work. We removed all the Sea Spurge at the back of the beach, all the Fleabane where the creek enters the beach and 95% of the Mother of Millions on the lower slope of the cliff.

The plan is to finish removal of Mother of Millions and spray the Beach Daisy at the back of the beach and Cape Ivy at the foot of the cliff within the next two weeks, as well as check for any subsequent growth in the areas covered.
